Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the joint protocol of cooperation between the Kingdom of Denmark and the Republic of Latvia signed in Copenhagen on 18 March 1991 which i.a. reconfirmed Denmark's recognition in 1921 of the Republic of Latvia as an independent state, and stated that Denmark and Latvia when the situation makes it possible will seek to reestablish diplomatic relations, as well as to the Danish letter of 24 August 1991 signed by H.E. Mr. Uffe Ellemann-Jensen, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Denmark on the reopening of diplomatic relations between our two countries with immediate effect.

I furthermore have the honour, acting upon instruction from my Government, to confirm the contents of the letter of 24 August 1991, and to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between our two Governments reconfirming the reopening of diplomatic relations between the Kingdom of Denmark and the Republic of Latvia as from 24 August 1991.

I avail myself of this opportunity to express to you, Sir, the assurance of my highest consideration.
