BETWEEN
THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA
AND
THE KINGDOM OF SPAIN


The Republic of Latvia and the Kingdom of Spain express the will to develop their relations in a spirit of friendship and co-operation based on the principles of mutual respect, sovereignty, equality and non-interference in the internal affairs of each state. They also declare that they are resolved to contribute to the progress of the international community on the basis of respect for peace and international law.

The Republic of Latvia and the Kingdom of Spain have agreed on this date to re-establish diplomatic relations and proceed, as soon as possible, to accredit Ambassadors to their respective Governments.

Both States are convinced that there are extensive possibilities for cooperation in the political, economical, cultural and other fields, aimed at mutual benefit and in the framework of attempting to contribute to the achievement of a stable and prosperous Europe.


