

JOINT DECLARATION ON THE REESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC
RELATIONS BETWEEN THE ITALIAN REPUBLIC AND
THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA

The Government of the Italian Republic and the Government of the Republic of Latvia have agreed, as of today, the reestablishment of diplomatic relations which were interrupted in 1940, following the annexation of Latvia by the Soviet Union, which Italy has never recognized.

The Government of the Italian Republic and the Government of the Republic of Latvia intend also to proceed to the exchange of resident Ambassadors as soon as possible.


While expressing their satisfaction at the important development occurred in their relations, the Government of the Italian Republic and the Government of the Republic of Latvia are committed to promoting them in a friendly and cooperative spirit on the basis of the principles of mutual respect, sovereignty, equality and non-interference in internal affairs of both States.
