It is with great pleasure that I inform you that the Government of Mexico has decided to propose to the Government of the Republic of Latvia the establishment of diplomatic relations between our two countries. In case this proposal is accepted by the Government of Latvia, the Ambassador of Mexico in Sweden will travel in the near future to Riga to initiate the necessary steps leading to formalizing these ties.

The bonds that we establish now will serve to favor closer ties between our people and will allow us to move forward in mutually advantageous cooperation efforts. Furthermore, in these times characterized by a growing international collaboration and dialogue, the Government of Mexico expresses its approval of the intention of the Republic of Latvia to join the United Nations.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew the assurances of my highest consideration.
