FOLLOWS TEXT OF MESSAGE FROM THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA P.V. NARASIMHA RAO TO HIS EXCELLENCY ANATOLIS GORBUNOVS, PRESIDENT OF LATVIA.

QUOTE: EXCELLENCY,

I HAVE LEARNT WITH SATISFACTION THE DECISION OF THE STATE COUNCIL OF THE SOVIET UNION TO GRANT INDEPENDENCE TO THE STATE OF LATVIA. WE WELCOME THIS DEVELOPMENT PARTICULARLY AS IT IS THE RESULT OF PEACEFUL NEGOTIATIONS AMONG THE PARTIES CONCERNED.

WHILE CONVEYING TO YOUR EXCELLENCY OUR DECISION TO RECOGNISE LATVIA AS A SOVEREIGN AND INDEPENDENT STATE, I WOULD LIKE TO SEND MY SINCERE FELICITATIONS ON THIS OCCASION. IT IS MY EARNEST HOPE THAT THE PEOPLES OF OUR TWO COUNTRIES WILL ENJOY DURABLE AND FRIENDLY RELATIONS AND MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL COOPERATION.

PLEASE ACCEPT, EXCELLENCY, THE ASSURANCES OF MY HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.
