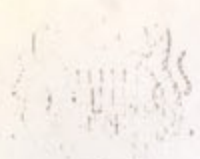

REMARKS:

Excellency,

I have pleasure in informing Your Excellency that the Malaysian Government yesterday announced its recognition for the independence of the Republic of Latvia. The Government of Malaysia will also extend support for the membership by the Republic of Latvia into the United Nations.

The Government of Malaysia looks forward to the early establishment of diplomatic relations between Malaysia and the Republic of Latvia. In the meantime we stand ready to establish immediate political and economic cooperation with the Government and people of Latvia.
